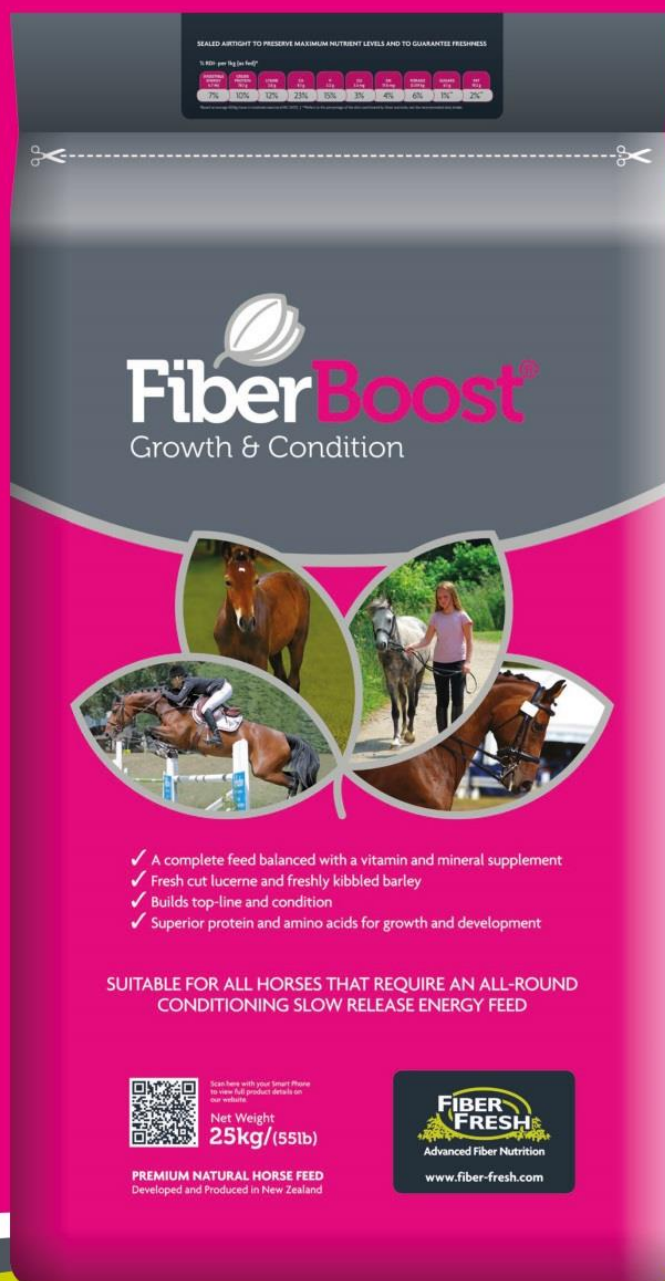

1. A purchase shall be deemed to be made when the offer is accepted or a deal successfully negotiated and the mare cleared by the Stud;
2. The purchase price is exclusive of GST and GST shall be payable on successful purchases;
3. I agree that should I be successful in making a purchase, I will be required to pay a 10% Usage Deposit of the purchase price plus GST to Racing Te Aroha, within seven days of notification of the purchase being successful (non-refundable);
4. I agree to pay the balance of the purchase price plus GST to Racing Te Aroha within (14) days of obtaining a 42 day Positive Pregnancy Test. In the event of a mare being walked into a stud or leaves the stud before the 42 days test, as owner I shall have the mare Pregnancy Tested at 42 days and the results forwarded to the Club. If no 42 day test is forwarded to the Club, the Club shall take it that the mare is in foal unless certified otherwise;
5. Interest of 6% per annum will be charged on a daily basis on all accounts not paid by Tuesday 20th of March 2018;
6. I understand that the service is for the 2016 Season only and that a LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE will be given on mares certified in foal;
7. I understand that a live foal is one who Stands, Suckles and is insurable at 24 hours;
8. Live Foal Guarantee:
 - a) This L.F.G. will only apply if all charges are paid as at Tuesday, 20th March 2018;
 - b) Should a Live Foal as described in Clause 7 not eventuate the Club reserves the right to give a free return or a refund of the money paid per Clause 4, provided the mare is foaled at a stud or an approved agistment property;

BATTLE PAINT

(USA) 2004 Bay (Tale of the Cat – Black Speak by Arch)

Commenced stud duties 2010. He was a very talented juvenile who won his first two starts in France prior to running a game second to Holy Roman Emperor in the **GR1** Grand Criterium at Longchamp. As a 3YO he was an unplaced favourite for the French 2000 guineas in between a couple of **GR3** placings over 1600m. The following year he won impressively first up at Doncaster over 6f and was soon after retired to stud. By the well know sire, **Tale of the Cat** who has left 103 SW to date. He is a half-brother to UAE Derby Winner **Helene Super Star** also the **GR2** winner **Homebound** and the **GR3** winner **War Flag** and the good listed winner **Blue Exit**. His dam won in France and is a half-sister to the outstanding US sire **Dynaformer** who currently stands for a fee of \$150k. This is a world-renowned stallion making family. His oldest progeny will be 6 year olds 2017/2018 and include Champion Singapore 2YO and 3YO **Affleck**, and the **GR2** WINNER **Battle Time** who has also had two **GR1** second placings.

BULLBARS

(AUS) 2007 Brown (Elusive Quality – Accessories by Singspiel)

Commenced stud duties in 2012. His sire was the Champion Sire of USA in 2007 and leading sire of 2YO in Australia 2010/2011. Also Champion Sire in **Brazil** 2014/2015. His dam was an un-raced **Singspiel** (98SW) mare who has had four to the races, all winners and all SW's. He is half-brother to the multiple **GR1** winners **Helmet** and **Epaulette** both of whom are how very fashionable sires themselves. His other sibling is **Pearls** (winner of Tea Rose S **GR2** and Toy Show H **GR3**).

He was also a very successful racehorse himself being a metropolitan winner, over 1100m his only start at 2yr's. The next season he was the brilliant winner of the prestigious CS Hayes S **GR3**; 1400m. This is a race that is regarded as being a pathway for stallions (e.g. **Zabeel**, **Starcraft**, **Mossman** and **Dash For Cash**). He was also multiple group-placed in this season including 2nd VRC Aust GNS **GR1**, 1600m and 3rd MVRC Bill Stutt S **GR 2**, 1600m.

From his first crop of 21 starters he has so far left 9 winners including **El Sicario** 2nd M/W Sires Produce S **GR1** and **Mongolianlightning** 3rd ARC Bonecrusher S **GR3** also **Ruthless Agent** unbeaten in three starts in Aust. It is worth noting that he has had five individual winners across the Tasman. His first two crops of yearlings were particularly well received at Karaka and have ended up in the hands of many leading Trainers.

BURGUNDY

(NZ) 2008 Bay (Redoute's Choice – Grand Echezeaux by Zabeel)

Commenced stud duties in 2013. His oldest progeny will be 3 year olds 2017-2018. He was a stakes winning top class racehorse (12 starts, 7 wins, 3 placings) who was rated second top-weight on the 2011-2012 3YO Free Handicap.

As a 4YO he trained on to win two listed races leading up to his memorably gallant 3rd placing in WRC Telegraph H **GR1** (1200m to **Final Touch** and **Xanadu**). He carries the most impeccable bloodlines imaginable being by the Champion Sire in **Redoubt's Choice** (146 SW) from a Champion broodmare who won at **GR1** level who is also the dam of that outstanding sire in **Darci Brahma**, she being by the all-conquering **Zabeel**.

This is the wonderful Pencarrow family of **Romanee Conti** and **Ethereal**. It is great for our industry that such a well-credentialed young stallion can have the opportunity to stand at Australasia's most famous of all nurseries.

His first three 2YO's to the races all won on debut. From a total of 8 starters he had 3 winners and 2 place-getters including SW **Hard Merchandize** and SP **Bringer of War** (SGP – 2).

Before moving on to a career in Singapore. His grand-dam was the good SW mare **Dolka** who was by the famous **Shergar**. From just 30 starters he's now had 17 winners and numerous place getters. **Civics Rock** (Winner of 2014 Newmarket H) and **Celebrity Miss** (Rotorua Challenge P) and placed third in Hawkes Bay Livamol Classic **GR1**.

Sire of **13** Individual Stakes horses Inc **Natuzzi GR3** / multiple **GR1** placed, **Absolutely G3** Singapore, **Milo dual Guineas Winner**, and Stakes Performed **No Choice, Flash Hapi, Dezzies Dream, Coat of Arms, Technician, Gateway, Five Coats, Kubrera Warrior, Church Road** and **Dessies Delight**. Has had **3 2YO's** qualify for the prestigious **2YO Karaka Million**.

Very successful Sire in Singapore, Hong Kong and Macau. Strong demand continues for trial horses to Asia. Leaves youngsters with kind generous temperaments.

His dam was the Champion USA 3YO filly in 1987 and is by the renowned **Red Ransom** (110SW). To date he has left 204 individual winners with 16SW and 7SP. Including the **GR1** winning mares **Ekstreme** (Capt Cook S) and **Shez Sinsational**, Auckland Cup, Zabeel Classic and Waikato Int S, **Habibi** (NZ Derby etc). Also the outstanding 3 year old filly **Rising Romance** (Aust Oaks).

EL HERMANO

(NZ) 2005 Bay (Pins – Palos Verdes by Oakridge)

A full brother to the great racehorse **El Segundo**. He fetched A\$1.2m at the Sydney Easter Sale with vendors, Ancroft Stud, deciding to retain a 10% share in him because he was such an outstanding individual. Unfortunately he never made it to the racetrack due to a severe paddock injury incurred later that same year. His sire **Pins** has already left 74 SW and he comes from a family that is synonymous with Ancroft Stud going back to the great **Battle Waggon** who put their nursery on the map. He is a very honest stallion who from only a moderate number of starters has left 32 individual winners including **Farm Boy** (Avondale Cup **GR2**), **Underthemoonlight** (Taranaki Breeders S **GR3**), **El Pescado** (2nd Hawkes Bay Makfi S **GR1**) and **El Pistola** (2nd Auckland Cup **GR1**, 2nd Counties Cup **GR 3**).

EL ROCA

(AUS) 2010 Bay (Fastnet Rock – Rubimill by Rubiton)

Commenced stud duties in 2015. His oldest progeny are yearlings this season.

A beautifully bred and top-class racehorse, he was allocated top-weight of the 2013/2014 NZ 3YO Free HP (1200-1600) and was given an Annual Timeform (Aust) of 121 in that same year.

After a couple of easy victories as an early 3YO in NZ he headed across the ditch to take on their very best. He won the ATC Eskimo Prince S 1200m beating **Dissident** and was subsequently runner-up to him in Randwick GNS **GR1** 1600m. He was also 2nd in ATC Liverpool Cup **GR3** 1300m and Caulfield GNS Prelude **GR3** 1400m as well as 3rd in George Ryder S **GR1** 1500m.

His sire is Champion Racehorse and Champion International Stallion **Fastnet Rock** (114SW) who is still only middle-aged and very fertile.

His dam **Rubimill** is an unraced **Rubiton** (43SW) mare who is a full-sister to the outstanding 2YO **Millrich** (Sweet embrace S **GR3**, 2nd Silver Shadow **GR2**, 3rd Golden Slipper S **GR1**). She being the dam of the wonderful sprinters **Danerich** (Sire) and **Redzel**.

El Roca has been very well supported by breeders and has covered large books of well-bred broodmares.

(AUS) 2002 Bay (Montjeu – Proud Halo by Don't Say Halo)

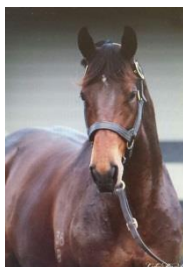
